How To Use This Journal

Complete a new entry before making any meaningful decision.

- investing money
- hiring someone
- changing careers
- buying a house
- starting a business
- making an important personal decision

Once the outcome becomes clear, return to the journal and complete the review.

Your goal isn't perfection.

Your goal is improving your thinking.

The Decision Framework

Before every important decision ask yourself:

1. What decision am I making?

2. Why does it matter?

3. What outcome do I want?

4. What assumptions am I making?

5. What evidence supports them?

6. What evidence challenges them?

7. What would make me change my mind?
